Jetcrete was originally established back in 1979 to undertake civil type projects and they joined the Byrnegut Mining Group of companies in 1994 to move into the tunnelling and mining industries. In 2004 they decided to drop the civil side of the business and concentrate 100% on mining. They also started in late 2008 a JV company in North America with Thyssen Mining Canada – Jetcrete North America that offers the same scope as in Australia.

Jetcrete are a specialised contractor that can manufacture, supply and apply shotcrete, which is a cost saving to most clients when they only deal with only one contractor. Their scope normally includes, Rehabilitation of bad ground, Shotcreting of Bulkheads, In cycle Shotcreting, High wall stabilisation's and Shaft linings with our Tele-remote shaft lining system.

Today they are currently working at such projects within Australia as Barrick Gold Australia's Osborne, Darlot, Wallaby, Raleigh and Plutonic operations, Newcrest Telfer Operations, Xstrata Nickel Cosmos Operations, Birla Nifty, Xstrata Copper Mt Isa Operations, Kagarra Zinc Mungana Operation and Carpentaria Gold Mt Wright operations with more due to start over the next few months.

They have over 150 employees and of these 60 plus would be certified internally as competent Nozzleman who applied well in excess of 120,000 cubic metres last year. Their recruiting level is a concrete batcher and they progress over time with training to a Nozzleman and so on.

They operate a large underground fleet of plant that is purpose built and have equipment operating on a daily basis including concrete spaying pumps, concrete transportation and agitator vehicles and concrete batching plants.
